<p>Self-Finishing Information:</p> <p>The paintable bisque finish will accept any paint or faux finishing technique currently available. Priming is not generally necessary for latex, acrylic, oil, or spray paint application. Since earthenware ceramic is slightly porous, it will absorb paint being applied, sometimes making a second coat necessary. Earthenware ceramic will also accept wet plaster or stucco, allowing the fixture to be mounted almost seamlessly.</p>
